

THSCC ANNUAL AUTOX TECH INSPECTION: Year 2026

- Throttle return spring (ignore if drive by wire).
- Battery securely mounted.
- Brake fluid level at manufacturers recommendation.
- Brake, gas and clutch pedal travel normal, brake pedal firm.
- All loose items removed from interior, attached floor mats ok.
- Loose cables secured.
- All lug nuts torqued to manufacturer specs.
- No items hanging from rear view mirror.
- Tire air pressure is set for autocross event.
- No cords showing on tires.
- No fluid leaks of any kind.
- Proper class and numbers on both sides of the car; Numbers at least 8" tall, letters 4" tall. Must be contrasting to car paint color.
- No play in wheel bearings, ball joints and tie rod ends. Any aftermarket suspension components are installed and torqued according to manufacturer specs.
- Decibel rules are enforced. Car will be failed if sound limit is above 96db at 50ft from the car.



Allowed helmets: Both open-face and closed-face style helmets meeting these certifications are permitted.

1. **By signing this form, you are agreeing to check the above items on the entered car prior to participating in any Tarheel Sports Car Club autocross event, including test/tune days, and autocross schools.**
2. The safety of any vehicle entered in any event shall be the sole responsibility of the driver.
3. Annual tech stickers shall only be issued to members in good standing with at least four events of verifiable autocross experience.
4. Annual tech privileges will be revoked if it is discovered that the entrant is not performing the checks listed above. Random checks may be performed at the Chief of Tech's discretion.
5. Annual tech inspection stickers are only good for the car originally inspected. If you are planning to run more than one car in a season, you must get each car inspected.
6. Annual tech inspections are only valid for the season for which the car was inspected as indicated below.
7. Annual tech inspections will only be available during the normal tech period for the first five autocross events of a THSCC season.
8. The Chief of Tech can revoke annual tech privileges at his/her discretion.
